## 1. Non-Active Medical Device

<p><b>1. Non-Implantable, General use</b></p>	<p>for anesthesia, emergency, and intensive care; for injection, infusion, transfusion, and dialysis; orthopedic and rehabilitation; with measurement function; ophthalmic.</p>
<p><b>2. Implantable</b></p>	<p>Cardiovascular; Orthopedics; Functional; Soft tissues.</p>
<p><b>3. For treating injuries</b></p>	<p>for treating injuries - Bandages and dressings; for treating injuries - Suture materials and staples; for treating injuries - Others.</p>
<p><b>4. Dental devices and accessories</b></p>	<p>Devices, equipment, and instruments; Dental materials; Dental implants.</p>

## 2. Active Medical Device - Non-implantable

<p><b>1. General use</b></p>	<p>for extracorporeal circulation, infusion, and hemapheresis; respiratory, including hyperbaric chambers for oxygen therapy and inhalation anesthesia; for stimulation or inhibition; surgical; ophthalmic; Dental; for disinfection and sterilization; rehabilitation and active prosthetics; for positioning and transporting the patient; Software.</p>
<p><b>2. Imaging Device</b></p>	<p>Imaging devices - using ionizing radiation; Imaging devices - using non-ionizing radiation.</p>
<p><b>3. Monitoring device</b></p>	<p>of non-vital physiological parameters; of monitoring vital physiological parameters.</p>
<p><b>4. Radiotherapy and thermotherapy device</b></p>	<p>radiotherapy that uses ionizing radiation; radiotherapy that does not use ionizing radiation; thermotherapy - hyperthermia or hypothermia; shockwave therapy.</p>

## 3. DM - Active - Implantable

<p><b>1. General use</b></p>	<p>For stimulation/inhibition; For delivery of drugs or other substances; Replaces organ or organ function; Others not previously specified.</p>
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
